

TANGSHAN TANGLONG COMMISSIONS ITS SECOND GGBS PRODUCTION LINE

Tangshan Tanglong Materials Company Limited witnessed the successful commissioning of its second state-of-the-art UBE designed 0.6-million TPA GGBS (Ground Granulated Blast-furnace Slag) production line on July 8, 2008.

With Tanglong's first line (commissioned in late 2003) and Tang-Ang's mill (located at Tangshan Jingtang Port and commissioned in July 2007), EnGro's annual GGBS production capacity in Hebei has risen to 1.8 million tons. EnGro's annual total combined GGBS production capacity from its seven mills spread across three provinces in China (Shandong, Hebei and Jiangsu) now stands at 4.2 million tons, making it one of the largest GGBS production entities in China.

Both Tanglong and Tang-Ang mills are ideally located to tap into the integration and fusion of the economies of the emerging Beijing, Tianjin and Bohai Bay Rim, which will hold the key to the country's development in the coming decades.
